**ORDINANCE NO. 5 - 2010
AMENDING ORDINANCE CHAPTER 48 PURCHASE OF DEVELOPMENT
RIGHTS**

The Ann Arbor Charter Township Board of Trustees ordains that the definition of “farmland and open space” in Section 48 – 22, Definitions, of Article II of Chapter 48 of the Township Code of Ordinances – Purchase of Development Rights is amended as follows:

**Article II Farmland and Open Space Land
Sec. 48 – 22**

The definition of Farmland and open space is amended to read as follows:

Farmland and open space land means those lands shown in the then current Township ~~general development Master Plan~~ as planned for agricultural ~~use or rural residential use (less than 0.2 dwelling unit per acre)~~ **preservation (overlay), plus an extension of such lands as may be approved by the Township Board in order to encompass contiguous portions of adjacent land under the same ownership and operated as one farm.**
